

# The Passion with the Liturgy of the Palms

Saturday, April 8 at 5:00 p.m.

Today Jesus entered the Holy City of Jerusalem in triumph. His path was lined with palms and shouts of praise but lead to self-giving, suffering and death.

#### **Stations of the Cross**

Tuesday, April 11 at 7:30 p.m.

Walking around the church, we stop at fourteen stations to reflect upon various points of our Lord's Passion and death.

# **Maundy Thursday**

Thursday, April 13, at 7:30 p.m. - Maundy Thursday worship On the night before his death Jesus set an example for his disciples by washing their feet, an act of humble service. Foot washing is done in the context of the Eucharist. The altar is stripped in preparation for Good Friday.

9:00 p.m. to midnight – Gethsemane Watch Jesus said to them, "Why are you sleeping? Get up and pray that you may not come into the time of trial."

12 noon - The Celebration of the Lord's Passion

This is the first service of Easter and includes the Service of Light, the Renewal of Baptismal Vows (possibly a Baptism) and Holy Eucharist.

# **40<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION**

On Sunday, April 30, at 10:30 a.m. we will gather as one community of faith to celebrate 40 years of ministry and worship here at St. Mark the Evangelist. We will be joined by our Bishop, The Rt. Rev. Dr. Geoffrey Peddle, and our celebrant that day will be our first Rector, The Rev. Charles Hiscock. Both our choir and our Saturday band will lead us in music and singing. There will be a reception following worship and there is a signup sheet in the parish hall for anyone who would like to help out by bringing food or helping with setup or cleanup. Please note there will be no 5:00 p.m. Saturday or 8:30 a.m. Sunday worship that weekend.

# PASTORAL CARE AT EASTERN HEALTH

Pastoral/Spiritual Care is available to all who enter an Eastern Health facility. To avail of this ministry of the church, upon admission, you (or your next of kin) will be asked if you would like to receive pastoral care. If you answer 'yes' and state your denomination you will be added to the list of patients to be visited by the chaplain and/or pastoral visitor. If you answer 'no' your choice will be respected and you will not receive a pastoral visit. Should you later change your mind please advise the nurse or the Pastoral Care office at 777-6959. Chaplains are bound by the Protection of Information Act. Chaplains can only advise your parish clergy of your admission with your consent.

For the past three years the Anglican, Roman Catholic, Salvation Army and United Church denominations have worked together to provide a First Call Chaplain for afterhours calls (5 p.m. – 7 a.m.) at the Health Sciences, Miller Centre, St. Clare's and Waterford Hospitals. The chaplain on call will respond and can make contact with the denominational chaplain if requested or needed. The denominational chaplain will continue to visit during regular daytime hours (7 a.m. – 5 p.m.).
